²Amphetamines examples used in survey wording: ADAS-uppers, bennies, speed, etc., not including legal stimulants. MTF-uppers, ups, pep pills, and drugs like Adderall and Ritalin, taken without a doctor telling you to take them and not including nonprescription drugs.

³Other psychedelics examples used in survey wording: ADAS-mescaline, peyote, mushrooms, etc.; MTF- Mescaline, Peyote, "Shrooms" or Psilocybin, PCP. MTF uses the wording "hallucinogens" in place of "psychedelics".
