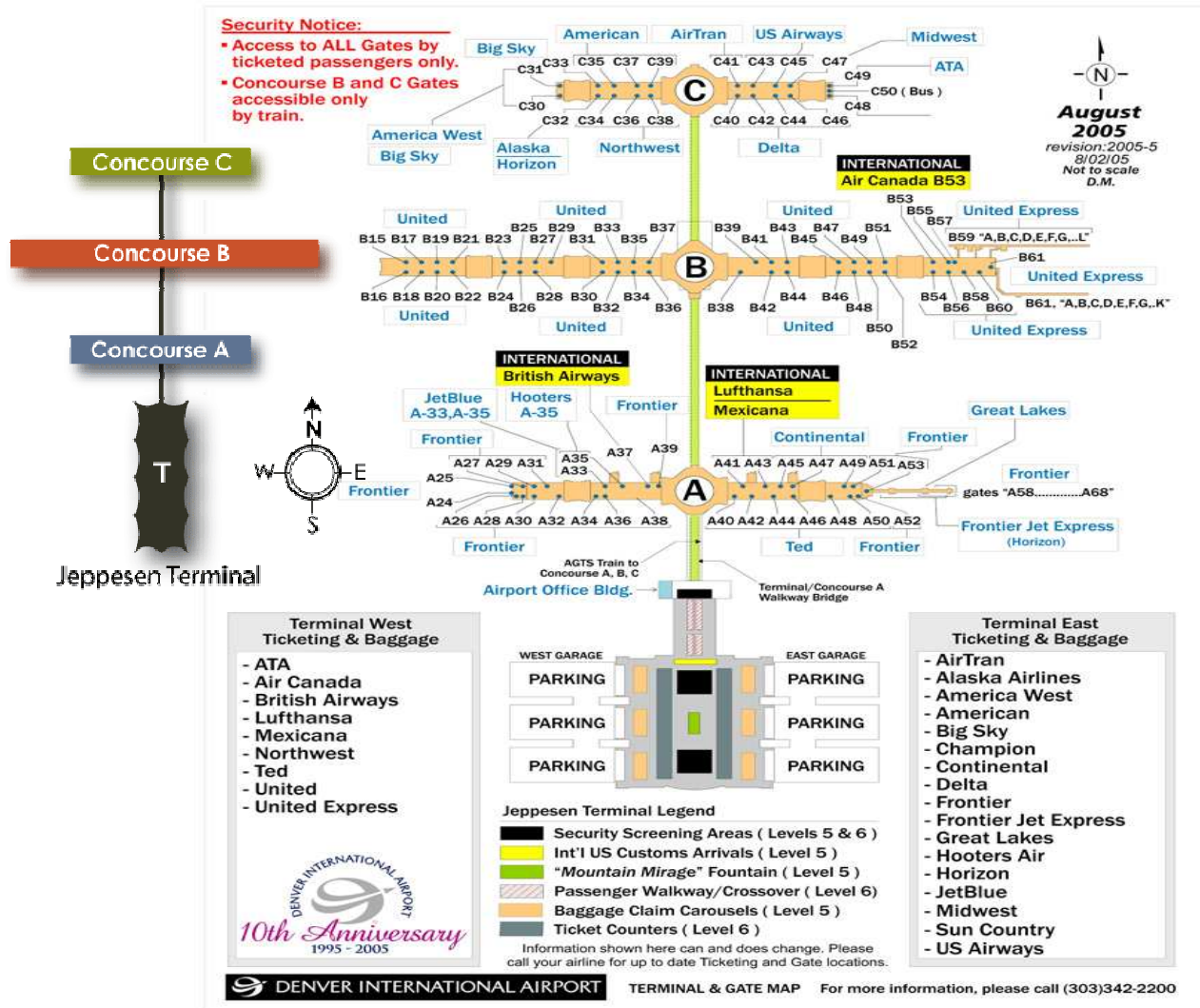

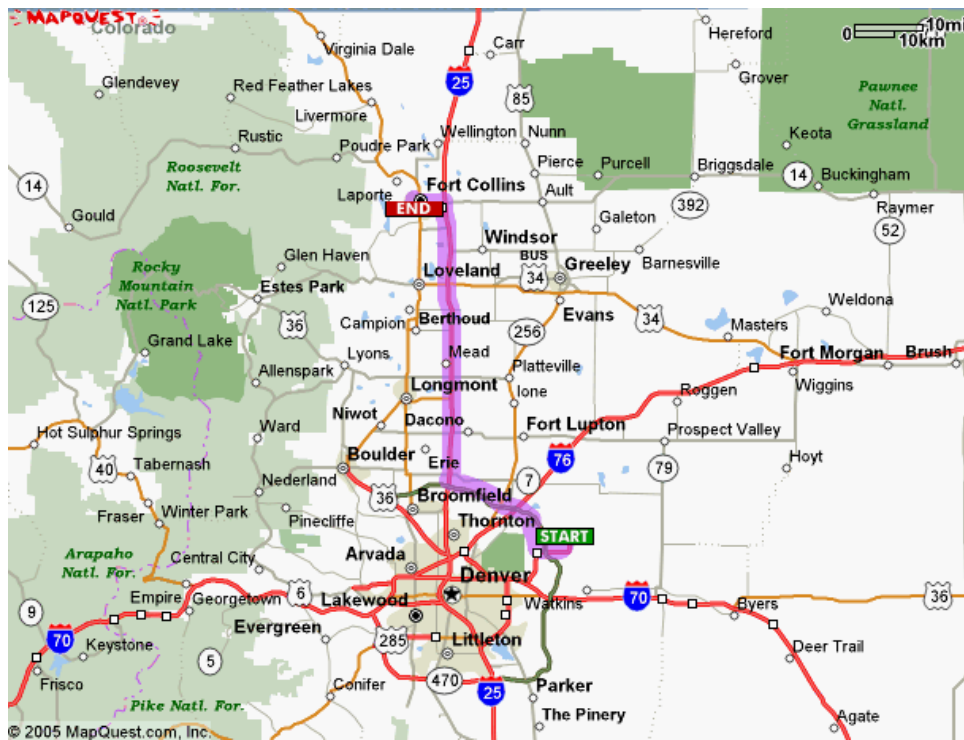

Driving from DIA to Fort Collins

1. Start out going West on Pena Blvd
2. Take the E-470 TOLLWAY N exit- EXIT 6B- toward FORT COLLINS.
3. Merge onto E 470 N (Portions toll).
4. Merge onto I-25 N / US-87 N via EXIT 47 toward FT COLLINS
5. There are three Exits into Fort Collins:
 - Harmony Road Exit 265
 - Prospect Road Exit 268
 - Mulberry Street Exit 269B

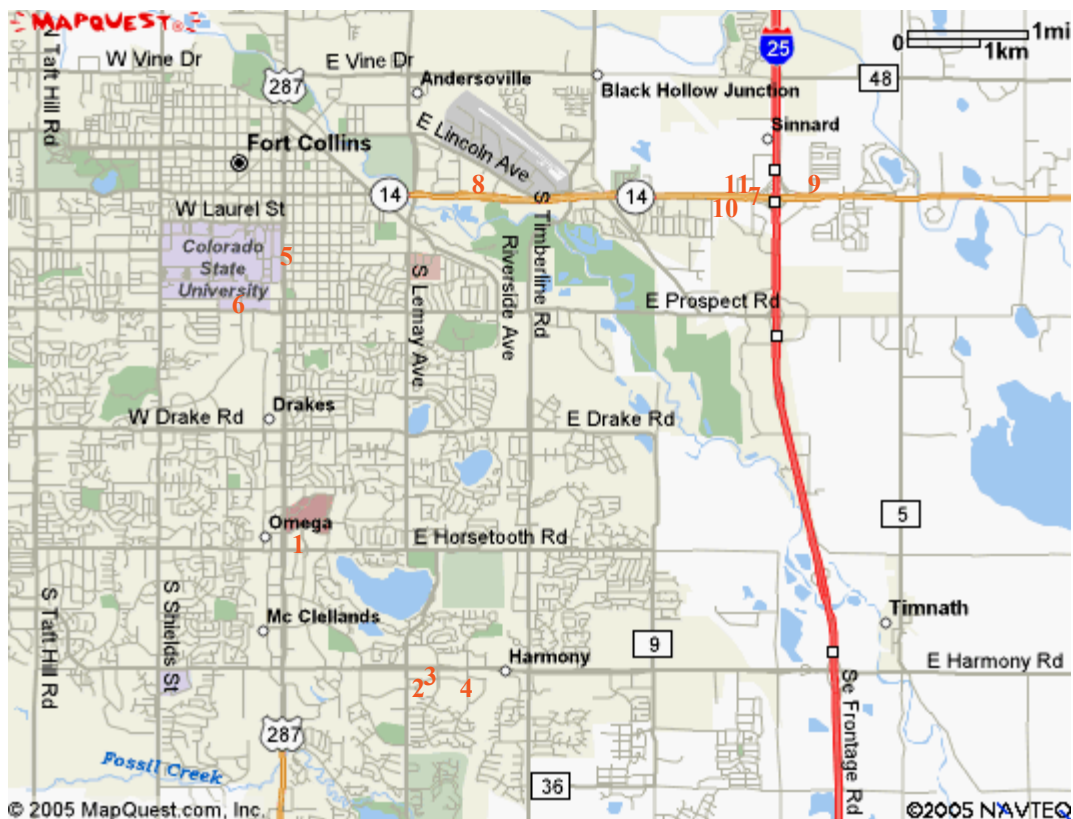

Will take you to:

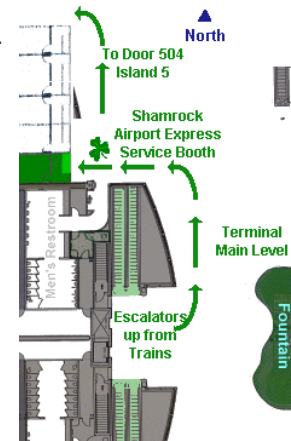
Courtyard Marriot, Marriot Hotel, Hilton Fort Collins, CSU Transit Center or to your door.

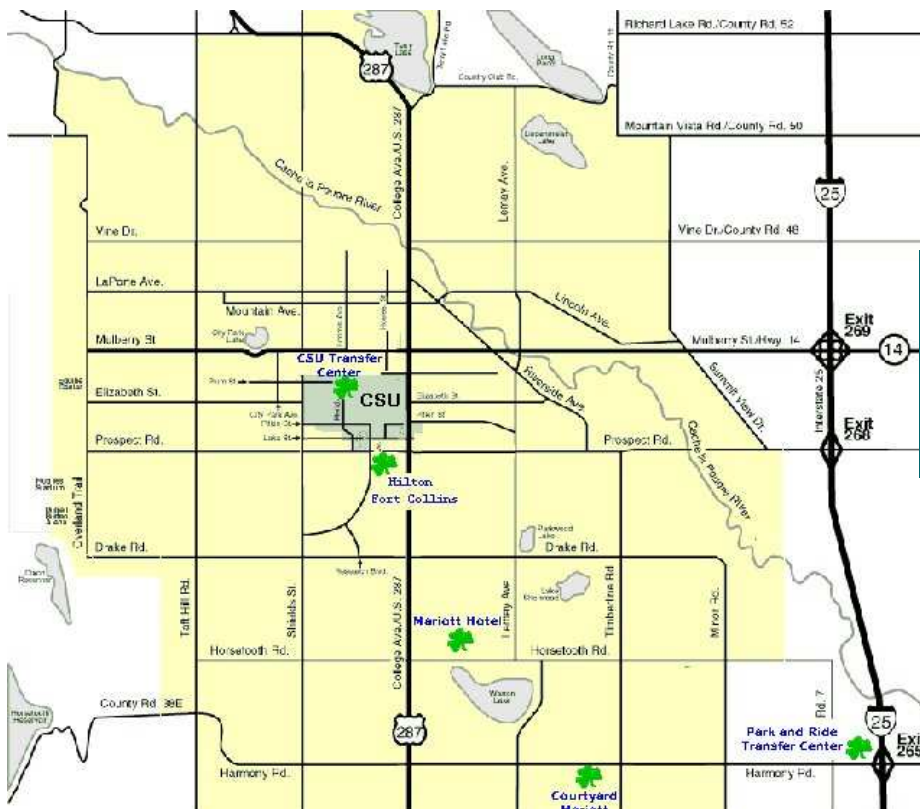
Luggage: Passengers are limited to two pieces of luggage and one carry-on. Certain items are charged an extra handling fee.

Standard Rates (Fort Collins):

Adult: \$26.00, 12 and under: \$8:00, Child on lap: no charge, Home Pickup (per stop): +\$5.00, CSU Pickup (per passenger): +\$3.00.

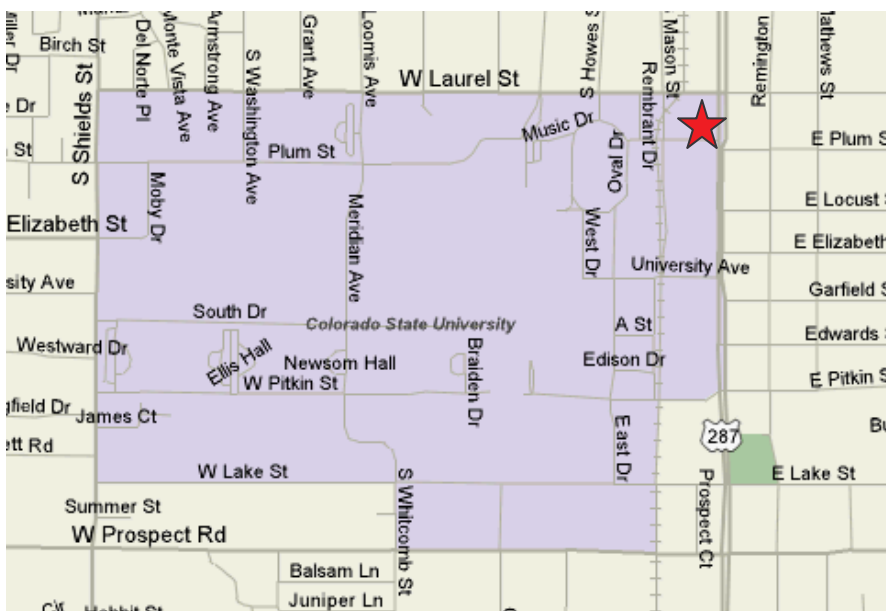
The Tri-Ethnic Center for Prevention research is administratively located within the Department of Psychology and College of Natural Science at Colorado State University. The Center has a 30-year history of broad-based, multidisciplinary and multifaceted research efforts aimed at understanding community dynamics and the social, psychological and cultural factors that contribute to social problems such as substance use, delinquency, dropout, intimate partner violence, HIV/AIDS, anger and anger management, school violence, avoidable injuries, car crashes and environmental and other social problems. The Center has been designated a Center of Excellence by the Colorado Commission on Higher Education and has been chosen as a Program of Research and Scholarly Excellence at Colorado State University for the past 10 years.



Directions:

The Tri-Ethnic Center is located on the corner of Laurel and College (Hwy 287).

From Laurel: Turn South onto Mason (railroad tracks) take an immediate left (East) into a parking lot. There are two brick buildings. The Tri-Ethnic Center is in Sage Hall. It is the smaller of the two buildings.



Feel Free to park in the "Z" lot in front of the building, but please let us know as soon as you enter the building so that we can issue you a special temporary parking permit for the day. If you do not have a special permit, it is almost guaranteed that you will receive a ticket.
